

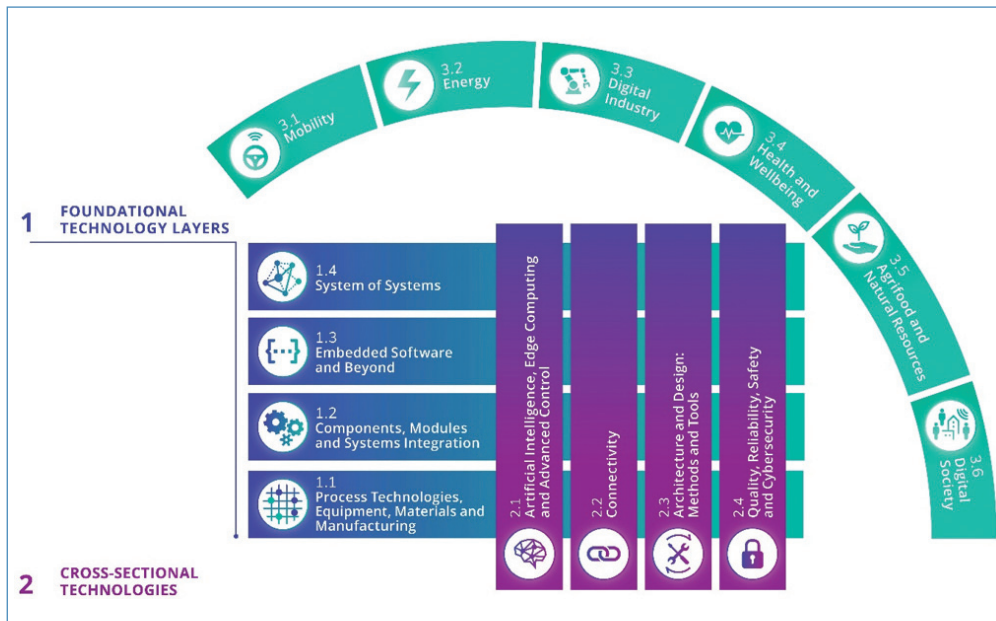

The ECSEL Mirror Group Italy has been established in Italy at the end of 2015, with the purpose to support the Italian participation in the ECSEL Joint Undertaking. It involves the Italian government through the Ministries of Research and University (MIUR) and of Economic Development (MISE), the Regions, the Large Enterprise, the SMEs, the ANIE Federation and AEIT-AMES.

Electronic Components and Systems (ECS) are one of the pillars of the Digital Europe Program 2021-2027 of the European Commission that is planning an investment of 9.2 Billion Euro in the next seven years.

In Italy, digital technologies are part of the Piano Nazionale della Ricerca (PNR), edited by MUR, and in the Piano Nazionale di Ripresa e Resilienza (PNRR), but also of the activities of the new Ministries for the Technological Innovation and Digitalization and for the Ecological Transition.

ECSEL Italy has organized for May 19, starting at 9:30 a.m. a virtual workshop on the research and innovation programs for ECS, in order to give updated information on the funding opportunities for research and innovation activities in this field.
