



Combine European, national and **regional** support with private funds






RIS3: Smart Specialization Cohesion Policy



Following the example of ECSEL Mirror Groups in Austria and Germany:


- To facilitate / coordinate the participation of Italian industrial and academic research organizations to the Joint Technology Initiative ECSEL.

- Re-establish Italian public participation in ECSEL.


A European Vision:

- Coordinate project submission and support formation of consortia (also in view of Lighthouse initiatives).




A short history

Management Structure






International visibility
