Who can participate?

The KDT JU Programme is open to any organisation that can make a contribution to the RDSI objectives of the programme. However, there are specific eligibility criteria relevant in the each KDT JU Participating State; these are listed in the KDT JU Work Programme 2021 (see below).

IA FOCUS TOPICS

Development of open-source RISC-V building blocks

Overall strategy: goal to develop RISC-V to become a widespread industry standard alternative to today's proprietary Instruction Set Architectures (ISA). For this, RISC-V needs a **powerful ecosystem** comprising technology, business models and pioneering use-case applications. Consortia should include partners to cover this entire value chain.

Details (some):

- Part of a **series of calls** (refer to tomorrow)
- Proposals need to give evidence of **readiness to cooperate with and provide clear inputs** to future RISC-V actions and/or initiatives
- Selected actions will be implemented as **'linked actions'**, i.e. they are linked with other actions selected under 'RISC-V' topics in this call and future calls.
- Proposals for this call will develop RISC-V **compliant IP blocks**. Certain IP blocks may be proprietary solutions; however, a large share of developed building blocks provided with a **permissive open-source licence** is preferred. All developed blocks must come with **publicly available documentation, benchmarks, verification suites, and validated reference designs** (including firmware/drivers, if required). One or more **demonstrators** should be built in a close to industrial environment with a number of RISC-V building blocks.

RIA FOCUS TOPICS

Processing solutions for AI at the edge addressing the design stack and middleware

Overall strategy: need to **reinforce processors and semiconductor technology** for data processing, communication & related data infrastructure as well as **new applications of AI at the edge**.

Details:

- It is foreseen that this topic will remain, in the **next KDT calls**, a focus topic if possible at higher TRL provided sufficient progress has been made
- Development of **European processors/accelerators** for secure embedded intelligence supporting inference and machine learning in autonomous intelligent objects and AIoT (Artificial Intelligence of Things) at the edge.
- Development of **platforms and automated tools for HW/SW co-design** of edge-AI based systems including non traditional computing paradigms (e.g. neuromorphic).
- Development of **AI software algorithms and/or frameworks** and tools for dealing with sparse computing resources for edge-AI based systems.
- **Encouraging SMEs to participate in those developments**, in particular paying attention to the needs of SMEs, involve SMEs in project execution, and develop solutions that can be taken up and/or exploited by SMEs

21/01/2022	The KDT JU Work Programme 2021 has been updated with information about the national eligibility rules for IT (MUR) (pages 98-101) and ES (MUNAED, 4E) (pages 125-132) a clerical error copy/paste was corrected in the sections "Artificial Intelligence" and "Connectivity" (pages 18 & 33); the national budgets table has been updated for IT(MUR), EL and SE (page 16)
21/01/2022	The complex funding rates of IA and RIA KDT JU calls 2021 and the limitations of the submission system resulted in the fact that the funding rates of the large enterprises (for profit not SMEs) are not adequately integrated in the JU/EU Budget table in the Part A. Consequently, these organizations need to calculate their JU/EU Funding as instructed in the Guide for Applicants (examples for each Call/topic are presented). Similarly, the National Budgets/Funding Table are not anymore integrated into the Part A (as it was the case in the past for the ECSEL JU) and it needs to be uploaded as a separate xls file in the dedicated place holder in the submission tool. More details/instructions are provided in the Guide for Applicants The Part C are now named National Part in the submission tool to avoid confusion with the Part C (dynamic forms) used by other programmes. More details are provided in the Guide for Applicants

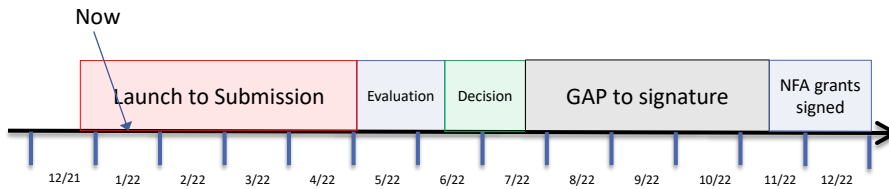
SCHEDULE

All Calls 2021 will be single-stage calls with submission of Full Project Proposal (FPP)

- Publication date: 16 December 2021
- Opening date of the submission tools in the Funding and Tenders portal (estimated): 18 January 2022
- Deadline (FPP proposals): at 17:00:00 Brussels time on 27 April 2022
- Evaluation mid June
- Selection mid July then GAP
- Signature of grant agreement before end of year!

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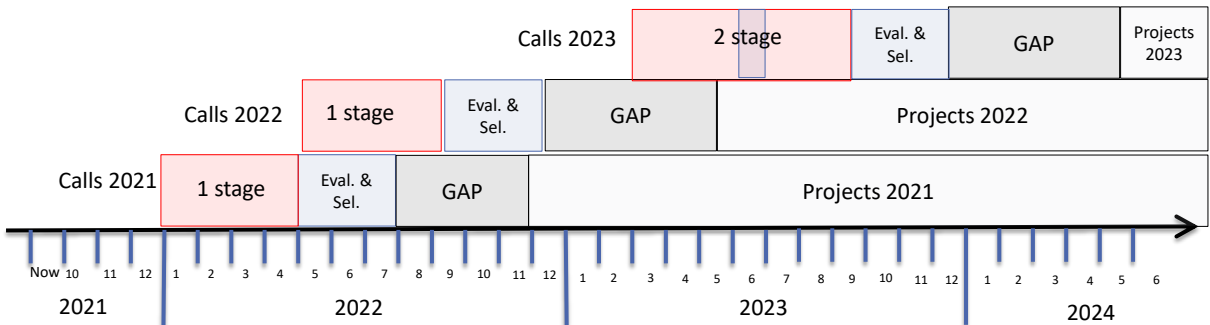
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UPCOMING CALLS

KDT CALL 2021: OTHER CHARACTERISTICS

- Major challenges according to ECS SRIA 2021
- Conditions are very similar to the ECSEL calls 2020 (page limits, sizes, etc.)
- EU funding rates very similar to ECSEL except for SMEs (see next)
- National funding shall be commensurate to the EU funding rates
- EU budget maximum 208 million Euro
- Total national budget 161 million Euro
- KDT encourages projects of all sizes! Small projects are certainly welcome.

FUNDING RATES IN THE BUDGET TABLE IN PART AB

Due to limitations of the submission tool the funding rate of the large enterprises is not taken into account in the budget table of the Part A. Therefore, the large enterprises need to check the funding rates they are entitled to in the Work Programme, calculate the EU Funding/contribution outside the portal and fill in the calculated amount in the budget table in the column named “**Requested EU contribution to eligible costs**”

An example provided below for a large enterprise (LE) participating to the IA call – funding rate 20%; portal indicates 30% (which is for SMEs only). Large enterprise calculates 20% of the total eligible costs and introduces manually the amount in the “Requested EU contribution to eligible costs”

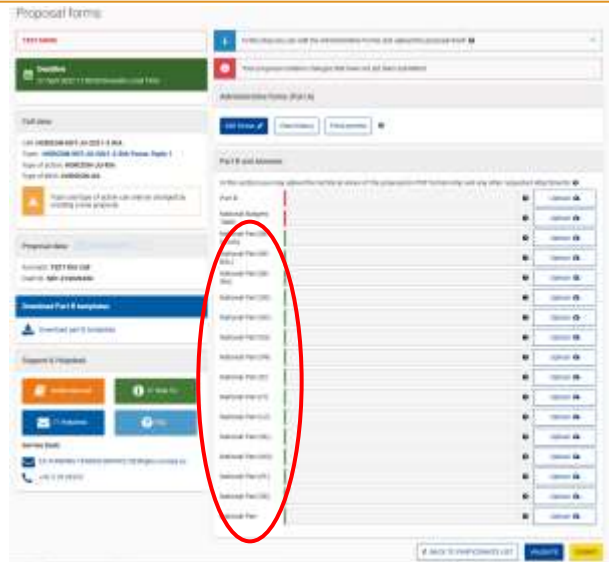

NATIONAL PART (KNOWN ALSO AS PART C)

The previous Part C are now named **National Part** and have a dedicated **Place Holder** for each of the KDT JU Participating State that request such an annex.

Instructions about these annexes are provided in the Annex 3 of the Work Programme of the respective Participating States.

(The name changed in order to avoid the system blockages due to confusion with the Part C which is now dedicated nomenclature in some Horizon Europe programme (dynamic forms which are automatically checked by the system every time a "Part C" name appears.)



NATIONAL BUDGETS TABLE

(Due to limitations of the submission tool the table for the national funding (eligible costs according to the national rules and national contributions requested) is not anymore integrated in the Part A (Administrative Forms) but has to be submitted separately as an xls file which must be uploaded to the dedicated placeholder named “National Budgets Table”)

The template is provided in the “**Download Part B template**” tab together with the Part B template (as a zip file which includes the xls template for the National Budgets Table and the rft template for the Part B)
