Partnership-Horizon Europe

- The Ministry of Economic Development (MISE) is engaged in the implementation of the interventions of National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR); Mission M4-Component C2; Id 12.2-Partnership Horizon Europe
- The financial resources, referred to the above Mission, were allocated to MISE as per the Ministry of Economy and Finance Decree, August 06, 2021
- KDT JU is one of the Partnership in which MISE is involved



Ministerial Decree & Directorial Decree

- The projects financed by the Ministry of Economic Development (MISE) shall comply with the acts related to the specific measure such as Ministerial Decree to be signed specifically on KDT calls, and following DGTCSI-DGIAI Directorial Decree.

Tagging

Projects must contribute to the achievement of climate objectives and to the digital transition as per Annex VI and Annex VII of the Regulation (EU) 2021/241

DNSH - (DNSH-Do Not Significant Harm)

Applicants will be selected taking into account their capability to be environmentally sustainable in line with Regulation (EU) 2020/852 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Delegated Act C(2021) 2800, June 04, 2021 describing the general criteria so that every single economic activity does not cause significant harm (DNSH-Do Not Significant Harm) by contributing to the objectives of mitigation, adaptation and reduction of environmental impacts and risks.

 Additional information on the above requirements will be highlighted both in the Ministerial and Directorial Decree



Type or nature of participants

- The following entities are eligible:
- Enterprises

- Universities, research centers and research organizations - only in collaboration with enterprises with which to set up a Consortium or a Network of Companies



Budget available and calls supported

-In order to contribute to the development of a strong and competitive industry in the electronic components and systems sector, MISE committed a budget of 10 million euro by supporting the Calls 2021-1-IA, 2021-1-IA Focus Topic, 2021-2-RIA and 2021-2-RIA Focus Topic 1.

-Each project will be funded by respecting the threshold of Euro 2.500.000,00 (maximum amount of the contribution)



Eligibility of costs

All costs incurred during the lifetime of a project under the following categories are eligible: personnel, equipment, subcontracting, consumables, and overheads. Overheads are calculated as a fixed percentage 25% of eligible costs of the project, as established by art. 20 of the delegated regulation (EU) n 480/2014 and by art. 29 of the regulation (EU) n. 1290/2013. They include also communication, dissemination and travel expenses
